Resolution # 06-2024-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLE SMITHFIELD PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION FOR THE ELECTED TOWNSHIP AUDITORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 65902 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE .

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 10 of 2024, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of auditors of townships of the second class;

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by Act 10 of 2024 authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, to increase the compensation of auditors subject to the limitations set forth in the Act;

WHEREAS, in particular, Section 65902 of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to increase the rate of compensation for each auditor to an amount not greater than eighteen dollars (\$18.00) for each hour employed in the duties of the office upon presentation to the Board of Supervisors of an itemized listing of the dates, times, places and hours worked; and,

WHEREAS, the Middle Smithfield Township Board of Supervisors intends to and hereby does increase the rate of compensation for each auditor to an amount of eighteen dollars (\$18.00) for each hour employed in the duties of the office in accordance with and subject to the limitations of 53 P.S. §65902.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that each elected auditor of the Township of Middle Smithfield entering office after the effective date of this resolution shall receive compensation for each hour necessarily employed in the duties as a Township Auditor in accordance with the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code in the amount of eighteen dollars (\$18.00) per hour, subject to and not to exceed those compensation limits set forth in 53 P.S. §65902.

Be it further resolved that this resolution and the increased auditor compensation shall only apply to those auditors elected to office following the date of the adoption of this resolution. The increase in elected auditor compensation provided for in this resolution shall not apply to those auditors already in office at the time this resolution takes effect and will only become effective for those auditors already in office upon the election or appointment to a future term of office in accordance with Pennsylvania Law.




