BE IT RESOLVED, that Middle Smithfield Township of Monroe County hereby requests a Statewide Local Share Assessment grant of \$291,925 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for upgrades to the Community & Cultural Center (C&CC), including the construction of sidewalk and associated ADA-compliant ramps along Milford Road (SR 0209) in front of Echo Lake Park and the C&CC, and the installation of ADA-friendly automatic door openers and historical artifacts that were repurposed from the Mosier's Dairy Farm at the Community & Cultural Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Annette Atkinson, Chairperson for the Board of Supervisors, as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Middle Smithfield Township and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
