**ORDINANCE NO. 247**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF MIDDLE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP AT CHAPTER 176, TAXATION, ARTICLE V, VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM, SECTION 176-51.C, ELIGIBLE ENTITIES, BY ADDING MARSHALLS CREEK FIRE COMPANY EMS AND LEHMAN PIKE EMS TO THE LIST OF ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Middle Smithfield Township believes that it is in the best interest of the Township and the residents of the Township to amend the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Middle Smithfield by adding Marshalls Creek Fire Company EMS and Lehman Pike EMS to the list of Eligible Entities at Section 176-51.C, as set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Board of Supervisors of Middle Smithfield Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, that the Middle Smithfield Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended at Chapter 176, Taxation, Article V, Volunteer Service Credit Program, Section 176-51.C, Eligible Entities, by adding Marshalls Creek Fire Company EMS and Lehman Pike EMS to the list of Eligible Entities as follows:

**ARTICLE I.**

The Middle Smithfield Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended at Chapter 176, Taxation, Article V, Volunteer Service Credit Program, Section 176-51.C, Eligible Entities, by adding Marshalls Creek Fire Company EMS and Lehman Pike EMS to the list of Eligible Entities as follows:

**§176-51.C.** Eligible Entities. The volunteer service credit program is available to residents of the Township of Middle Smithfield who are volunteers of the following volunteer fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical service agencies that provide service to the Township of Middle Smithfield:

- (1) Bushkill Ambulance.
- (2) Suburban EMS.
- (3) Bushkill Fire Company.
- (4) Marshalls Creek Fire Company.
- (5) Shawnee Volunteer Fire Company.
- (6) Lehman Pike EMS
- (7) Marshalls Creek Fire Company EMS

**ARTICLE II. SEVERABILITY.**

It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that if a court of competent jurisdiction declares any provisions of this Ordinance to be invalid or ineffective in whole or in part, the effect of such decision shall be limited to those provisions which are expressly stated in the decision to be invalid or ineffective, and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall continue to be separately and fully effective. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section or part thereof, other than any part declared invalid, if it had advance knowledge that any part would be declared invalid.

### ARTICLE III. REPEALER.




All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

### ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
