A RESOLUTION OF MIDDLE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP

ADOPTING THE ACT 537 SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE

RESOLUTION OF THE MIDDLE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS OF MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter "the municipality").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the **Pennsylvania Code**, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, Middle Smithfield Township has prepared an Act 537 Plan Update which provides sewage facilities in a portion of Middle Smithfield Township, and

WHEREAS, this Plan Update is to document the purchase of the collection, conveyance, and treatment system owned by the Manwalamink Sewer Company. This portion of the sanitary sewer collection, conveyance, and treatment system will be purchased by the Pennsylvania American Water Company.

WHEREAS, Middle Smithfield Township finds that the Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Middle Smithfield Township hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval the above referenced Facility Plan. The municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
