Action Item	Priority	Responsible Parties	Implementation
1.1. Official Map	Short-term	PC, BOS, TE	Develop a Township Official Map based upon current and future needs and opportunities
1.2. Open Space, Recreation, Environmental Resources and Greenway Network Plan	Short-term	PR, PC, BOS, MCC, MCP	Evaluate and assess the existing resources and conditions, and develop a Plan based upon future needs, goals, and visions
1.3. Energy Efficiency and Sustainability Plan	Short-term	PC, BOS, MCC, MCP	Create an Energy Efficiency and Sustainability Plan in order to commit to a more energy efficient and sustainable way of living in the Township
1.4. Master Plan for the Route 209 and 402 Corridors	Short-term	PC, BOS, TE, EDA, EDM, PennDOT	Develop a Master Plan for the Route 209 and 402 Corridors including Streetscape Enhancements
1.5. Implement biannual Board and Commission progress report/summary meetings	Ongoing	BOS, PC, PR, EDA, HC, EDM	Coordinate biannual meetings with all Boards & Commissions to provide progress/summary reports and upcoming goals in order to create better interaction and coordination among Township Boards & Commissions
1.6. Support the recommendations of the County in various Plans	Ongoing	BOS, PC, EDA, EDM, TE	Support the 2014 Monroe County Comprehensive Plan, the County's Hazard Mitigation Plan, and the Eastern Monroe Active Transportation Plan
1.7. Coordinate planning with adjoining municipalities, the CJERP Group, and other regional entities	Ongoing	BOS, PC, EDA, EDM, TE	Join the regional planning groups
