WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. as amended mandates that all political subdivisions have a disaster emergency management plan. The Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) consists of a Basic Plan, a Notification and Resource Manual, and Checklists; and


WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, Middle Smithfield Township has prepared an Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster. The Basic Plan is attached hereto; and


WHEREAS, Middle Smithfield Township has also prepared a Notification and Resource Manual and Checklists, the contents of which are not subject to Pennsylvania's Right-to Know Law.


