

MIDDLE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP FEE SCHEDULE

RESOLUTION NUMBER: 05-2015-1

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, and other various statutes of the Commonwealth, and as permitted by various Chapters of the Code of the Township of Middle Smithfield, the Township may impose fees in connection with various Township services and activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Middle Smithfield that the following Township fees, as set forth below, are hereby established and/or confirmed, as may be applicable:

Conditional Uses and Curative Amendments

\$500.00*

*plus an additional fee of \$500.00 for each additional hearing day after the first hearing day. Each additional fee shall be due and owing, and shall be paid, no later than ten (10) days prior to each respective additional hearing day, or the application fee shall be consider unpaid.

Exemptions

Volunteer Fire Companies Non-Profit EMS Providers and 501(c)(3) companies may request a waiver of sign and yard sale fees as set forth above within this resolution. All other fees, as stated above within this resolution shall be paid for by said organization in accordance with the provisions herein.

Continuation of Other Existing Fees

All existing Township fees, not otherwise set forth in this schedule, remain in place and continue in effect until otherwise modified by the Board of Supervisors.
