

## MIDDLE SMITHFIELD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES OCTOBER 26, 2017

The regular meeting of the Middle Smithfield Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, October 26, 2017 at 7pm at the Schoonover Municipal Building with Annette Atkinson presiding.

Supervisors present, Annette Atkinson, Mike Dwyer and Mark Oney. Also in attendance: Township Solicitor Michael Gaul, Esq., Township Secretary Michael L. Clewell, Frank Smith of Frank Smith Surveyors, Charlie Vogt, Esq., Christopher McDermott, P.E. of Reilly Engineering, and Kevin Joyce from Pyramid Healthcare.

## **Approval of Minutes**

Annette Atkinson made a motion to approve the October 12, 2017 minutes. Mike Dwyer seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

## Report of Executive Session(s)

Attorney Gaul stated that an executive session was held prior to the meeting to go over pending legal matters with the township solicitor.

## Announcements

The township's first annual Veterans dinner will be held on November 10<sup>th</sup> at the CCP Banquet Hall. The Person of the Year and Volunteer Appreciation Banquet will also be held at the banquet hall on November 17<sup>th</sup>.

## Treasurer's Report

Mike Dwyer stated that the 2018 budget is currently being prepared. Year to date, the general funds income is 10% higher and expenses are 3% lower. The sewer fund is slightly lower. The golf fund is ahead of budget as income is higher than budgeted and expense are 10% lower.

Mike Dwyer made a motion to approve the general fund payables in the amount of \$131,285.73. Mark Oney seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Mike Dwyer made a motion to approve the sewer fund payables in the amount of \$65,053.83. Mark Oney seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Mike Dwyer made a motion to approve the golf course payables in the amount of \$21,730.41. Mark Oney seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

#### **Engineers Report**

## Maher Heaps Minor Subdivision

Frank Smith of Frank Smith P.L.S. presented the minor subdivision on behalf of his client. Attorney Vogt was also present.

Fred Courtright stated that the MST Planning Commission recommended approval of the plan modifications.

Mr. Smith stated that the property is on Hollow Road with a total area of 8 acres. Lot 1 has the Heaps home on it and Lot 2 is going to be conveyed to Ski Shawnee Inc. and made part of their lands. Attorney Gaul asked if there is wording on the plan stating that the lands will be conveyed. Mr. Smith said yes. It is Covenant #9.

There is no building proposed on Lot 2 as the purpose of the transfer is for protection purposes only.

## Modifications Requested;

- Wetland to be accurately shown on the plan; Lot 2 is being created solely to protect the Shawnee Creek and its wetlands. No building, well or septic are proposed. A non-build declaration has been executed.
- 2. <u>Steep slope areas (greater than 25%) to be depicted on the plan</u>; as no improvements are proposed for either lot, the applicant does not believe this item is necessary.
- 3. <u>Emergency grid lines</u>; ordinance requires emergency grid lines and numbers to be shown on the plan. Since the advent of the 911 system, the emergency grid number system is no longer used by Monroe County EMS.
- 4. <u>Sewage Planning Module</u>: as no building is proposed for Lot 2, the applicant does not believe this item is necessary.

Mike Dwyer made a motion to approve the Maher Heaps Minor Subdivision plan and four requests for modifications as listed. Mark Oney seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

<u>Pyramid Healthcare, Inc. Amended Land Development Plan</u>; Chris McDermott, P.E. of Reilly Engineering presented the plan on behalf of his client. Mr. Kevin Joyce of Pyramid Healthcare was also present to answer any questions.

Mr. McDermott stated that they presented a land development plan last December for a module building on the east side of the property. That building is under construction at this time. They had shown a temporary structure on the plan in December 2016. That building is why they are here tonight as the time frame is up to use the building due to it being a "temporary structure".

Mr. McDermott stated that they want to make that a permanent structure in order to house facility management personnel, such as IT, housekeeping and one desk. No patients will be located in this building. There is no additional parking, water and or sewer required. A ramp between the two buildings will be used.

Mr. Courtright stated that by asking for an amended plan, due to this appearing on the land development plan in December 2016, the township is being consistent, by having Pyramid come back in and amending the plan.

Attorney Gaul asked about the use of water and sewer for the personnel that will be in the building. Mr. McDermott stated that the water and sewer is located 120 feet away and he believes the ICC requirement is 300 feet. The structure was required to meet building codes even though it was considered "temporary".

Mark Oney asked where on the plan is the fire access. Mr. McDermott showed the supervisors where the access is located. Mike Dwyer asked about sprinklers, Mr. Joyce stated that they were not required; however the main building does have sprinklers.

#### **Modification Requests**

- 1. Required plan sheet size; request made to allow the standard 24" x 36" sheet size.
- 2. <u>Emergency grid lines</u>; ordinance requires emergency grid lines and numbers to be shown on the plan. Since the advent of the 911 system, the emergency grid number system is no longer used by Monroe County EMS.

Mark Oney made a motion to approve the Pyramid Healthcare, Inc. Amended Land Development Plan and two modification requests as listed. Mike Dwyer seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution 10-2017-1; PA DEP Sewage Planning Module for Component 2; Minor Subdivision of Land s of J. Bruce Bennett; Mike Dwyer made a motion to approve Resolution 10-2017-1 and forward the Sewage Planning Module for Component 2 to PA DEP. Mark Oney seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

Appoint Bob Philips to the Economic Development Committee to fill the remaining term of Carl Wilgus until December 31, 2019; Annette Atkinson made a motion to appoint Bob Phillips to the EDC to fill the remaining term of Carl Wilgus to December 31, 2017. Mike Dwyer seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

<u>Bushkill Fire Company; banner fee (\$125) waiver request;</u> Mark Oney made a motion to approve the Bushkill Fire Company request to waive the \$125 application fee to hang a banner on Route 209. Mike Dwyer seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-0.
