

Minutes: Parks & Recreation Committee - October 14, 2019

The regular meeting of the Middle Smithfield Township Parks and Recreation Committee was held on October 14, 2019 and began at 6:36pm at the Middle Smithfield Township Building with Jaime Frailey presiding.

Michelle Dellavalle made a motion to accept the minutes from the July meeting. Laura Massaro seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

She has plans to schedule several public demonstrations in 2020.
